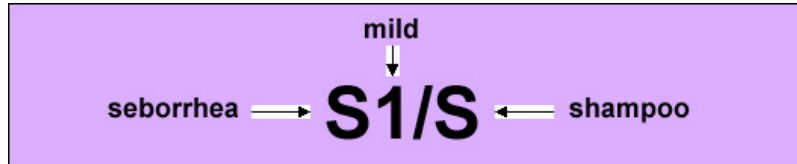


Naming Convention
↑

GlenHaven products are color-coded and follow a naming convention that uses a combination of letters and numbers.

The first letter references the Pet's clinical sign; the number categorizes the severity of the clinical sign; and third letter distinguishes the product type. For example, shampoo for mild seborrhea would be:



A slash separates the health problem and severity from the product type.

The legend for GlenHaven products is as follows:

A =	Allergies (allergic condition)	P =	Pseudomonas (bacteria)
B =	Bacteria	S =	Seborrhea (oily skin)
C =	Cerulytic (wax)	T =	Teeth
F =	Fungal (yeast)	Y =	Yeast
H =	Hypoallergenic (sensitive)
